1. The ORIGINAL text of the Bible (which we don't have in our possession) doesn't contain any errorshistorical or otherwise.	
2. There are some very minor copyist errors in the Bible manuscripts, but they	
are very rare and don't affect any doctrine at all. Its been suggested that the	
Bible is 99,9% accurate, which is far more accurate than any other book of	
antiquity by a long shot
