Job, Psalms, Proverbs, Ecclesiastes & Song of Songs.

You'll discover 3 types of poetry, figures of speech, parallelism, etc.

Don't worry, it sounds more complicated than it is.

Week 3: Studying didactic literature....literature that's meant for learning how to live a godly life.

Why did the apostle Paul write the letter to the Colossians?

What are structural markers? (Ohhhh, sounds intellectual) See how right ideas lead to right living.

Romans thru Jude

Week 4: Studying prophetic & apocalyptic literature. Isaiah thru Malachi & Revelation.

What to bring: A pen, a Bible & yourself.
