One possible explanation for an NDE'er seeing all those brilliant, never seen before colors in heaven:


I started out by reading Captain Dale Black's NDE. I stopped about half way thru after he had talked about the beautiful colors. I then gave everyone a physics lesson about light.

Light is made up of energy. Energy comes in waves, like the waves of an ocean. Energy is measured in the length of one of its waves. This is a distance measurement, albeit a very small one. The light we see has a range of certain wavelengths. There are wavelengths that are longer wavelengths that we cannot see. There are also shorter wavelengths that we cannot see. The longer wavelengths have less energy than visible light. The shorter wavelengths have a lot more energy than the light than we see. All of these wavelengths make up the energy spectrum.

The longer wavelengths are things like infra-red, microwave and radio waves. The shorter wavelengths are ultraviolet, X-rays and gamma rays. Our eyes can only see the visible light wavelengths, so there is a lot of other wavelengths that we cannot see. It may be possible that when a person has an NDE (near death experience) and they see colors that they've never seen before that they see these other wavelengths or at least some of them. Of course, they're seeing then with their spiritual eyes and not their physical eyes as their body is lying in a hospital bed.

FYI...our Sun emits energy in all of these wavelengths but more in some wavelengths than others. Gamma rays are very hi-energy waves that if they ever made it to the Earth's surface, all life would cease to exist as they would fry our human brains in seconds. What prevents them from reaching Earth's surface? High above our surface in the upper atmosphere is an ozone layer (O₃). Ozone is 3 oxygen atoms bound together. The gamma rays breakup the ozone into oxygen (O₂) and O. After awhile of bouncing around, the O₂ and O recombine to form O₃ again. Then another gamma ray hits it and the same thing happens again. So, the ozone layer is constantly being broken down and reformed again. Guess how thick the ozone layer is? Most people guess 1 mile or more. Its one inch thick. Amazing, isn't it. Even if astronomers identify a planet revolving around another star that might have liquid water on it (necessary for human life), it would have to have an ozone type layer in its atmosphere in it to protect against any gamma or X-rays hitting its surface. This is just one of the many things that make life on Earth possible. Isn't God great?

Some NDE'ers also report seeing more than the normal field of vision. Normal humans can see about 180 degrees in their field of vision. Rabbits can see about 300 degrees in their field of vision. But in their spiritual body, some NDE'ers claim they can see far more than 180 degrees. Some even claim to see the full 360 degrees. That's incredible, isn't it?



Dwight Lyman Moody was born the sixth child of Edwin and Betsy Holton Moody in Northfield, Massachusetts on February 5, 1837. Dwight's formal education ended after fifth grade, and he rapidly grew tired of life on the family farm. He left home at age 17 to seek employment in Boston.

After failing to secure a desirable position, he asked his uncle, Samuel Holton, for a job. Reluctantly, Uncle Samuel hired Dwight to work in his own retail shoe store. However, to keep young Moody out of mischief, employment was conditional upon his attendance at the Mt. Vernon Congregational Church.

At Mt. Vernon Moody became part of the Sunday school class taught by Edward Kimball. On April 21, 1855, Kimball visited the Holton Shoe Store, found Moody in a stockroom, and there spoke to him of the love of Christ. Shortly thereafter, Moody accepted the love of God and devoted his life to serving Him. The following year brought Moody to Chicago with dreams of making his fortune in the shoe business. As he achieved success in selling shoes, Moody grew interested in providing a Sunday School class for Chicago's children and the local Young Men's Christian Association.

During the revival of 1857 and 1858, Moody became more involved at the YMCA, performing janitorial jobs for the organization and serving wherever they needed him. In 1860 when he left the business world, he continued to increase his time spent serving the organization. In the YMCA's 1861–1862 annual report, Moody was praised for all his efforts. Although they could not pay him, the YMCA recommended he stay "employed" as city missionary.

Meanwhile, Moody's Mission Sunday School flourished, and it was different. Moody's desire was to reach the lost youth of the city: the children with little to no education, less than ideal family situations, and poor economic circumstances. Soon the Sunday School outgrew the converted saloon used as a meeting hall. As the classes grew, associates encouraged Moody to begin his own church. Eventually, on February 28, 1864, the Illinois Street Church (now The Moody Church) opened in its own building with Moody as pastor.

From there, he went on to be a great evangelist, leading MILLIONS TO THE IORD. The famous Moody Bible Institute in Chicago is his college.
